### ***Where do the explorers meet and how often?***

Meets twice a month on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays from 6 – 8pm at the La Crosse Police Dept. at 400 La Crosse Street. Sessions will begin on October 14, 2019.

### ***How much does it cost?***

There is an annual fee of \$37. Scholarships are available. Conferences and competitions are additional.

### ***What are the requirements?***

Exploring is a career education program for young men and women who are currently enrolled in high school and in good physical and mental health. The applicants must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and may not have any prior convictions for a criminal offense or serious traffic offense. The applicant's parent or guardian needs to sign the application and a release allowing their youth to participate in the program.

### ***How do I apply?***

Complete and submit a Law Enforcement Explorer interest form & signed waiver along with a copy of most recent academic grades to your School Resource Officer, your Student Services Office, or mail to Police Explorers, 400 La Crosse St. La Crosse, WI 54601, by 9/27/2019.
