Scouts in grades 4 and grades 5 will work on their Webelos and Arrow of Light badges. Each badge has specific requirements. Scouts should earn the Webelos badge in grade 4 and Arrow of Light in grade 5. Sometimes Scouts will earn both in grade 5 if they did not participate in grade 4. 5th Graders should aim to 'cross over' into a Troop prior to April 1, 2021.

Duty to God and You: discuss your individual beliefs

First Responder: Learn about basic first aid

Stronger, Faster, Higher: do a variety of fitness related tasks

Webelos Walkabout: Outdoor hike with first aid and lessons about plants and animals

Required Adventures for Arrow of Light Award

Building a Better World: learn about a variety of local, national, and global civic lessons

Outdoor Adventurer: Go on a campout; learn a bowline knot; and how to be safe in a variety of weather

Duty to God in Action: learn about your faith and ways to impact the community

Scouting Adventure: learn about Scouts, BSA including Scout Oath, Law, and visiting a Troop
