APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your interest in the Engineering Exploring program sponsored by the La Crosse County Landfill, Trane, and Gateway Area Council BSA. Here is important information to be an applicant:

REQUIREMENTS:

AGE: Currently enrolled in high school.

APPROVALS: Have parent / guardian approval to participate in Explorer activities.

ADDITIONAL RQMTS: Have a desire to learn. Make a commitment to at least 10 of the 15 meetings.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Complete the [BSA Exploring Youth Application](#), print, then sign, scan, and bring to session.
2. Complete the [Engineering Exploring Waiver](#)
3. Pay the [Explorer Fee Online](#) or bring check \$75 made out to BSA to session.

A selection of applicants will be made based on meeting the above requirements and space availability.

GUIDELINES

- Attend at least 10 sessions. Arrive or connect 10 minutes early so sessions can start on time.
- Prompt pickup of student.
- No use of cell phones during the exploring meetings unless it is required for the activity.
- If the explorer cannot make a meeting, they must notify LEAD ADVISOR at gatewayexploring@gmail.com before the meeting or it will be an "unexcused absence."

APPLICANT DISQUALIFICATION OR TERMINATION FACTORS:

Applicants are advised that areas for disqualification from further consideration or termination from program include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Two unexcused absences (no phone call or message sent ahead of session).
- Misconduct or behavioral disruption in exploring sessions.
