

# HOW TO USE BINOCULARS

## 1. Adjust the binoculars to fit you.

- Hold the binoculars up to your eyes and grasp each side firmly.
- Move the sides closer together or farther apart until they fit your eyes comfortably and you see only one round image.



## 2. Adjust the eyepieces

- Set the **right** eyepiece to **zero**
- Cover the **right front lens** with your hand
- Look through the **left eyepiece** and use the focusing lever in the **middle** of the binoculars to focus on a distant object
- Keep **both** eyes open while doing this
- Now cover the **left front lens** with your hand and rotate the right eyepiece from zero to plus or minus until the same distant image is sharp in your right eye.

## 3. Use the middle lever to focus on different distances.



\*Always keep the binoculars around your neck to avoid losing or dropping the binoculars.

\*Avoid getting the binoculars wet or dirty

\*Avoid looking at the sun.
